





The COVID-19 pandemic resulted in a significant decrease in ridership as the NY State Pause order went into effect and only essential workers were encouraged to ride NYC Ferry. A modified schedule went into effect on March 23 that was a 30% reduction of a typical spring schedule.



Jewel of the Harbor assisted a non-NYC Ferry vessel in distress at the beginning of January. Service to Bay Ridge and Rockaway was suspended due to high winds on two occasions. Three new NYC Ferry vessels were delivered to the NY Harbor.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops made within the quarter that depart no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes past their scheduled times. This report includes delays due to events outside of the control of NYC Ferry, such as vessel traffic, river closures/obstructions, extreme weather conditions, and other U.S. Coast Guard restrictions. When tracking devices are offline, the stops are excluded from the calculation. ²Number of NYCF-branded vessels available for use; NYCF Partners with other operators to charter vessels at times of high demand. ³NYCF operates to Governors Island on weekends during its public season. Figure includes average ridership on weekends when service operated in Q2. ⁴Governors Island ridership is included in this figure.
