



岩 Highlights

The pandemic continues to affect ridership, but NYC Ferry saw higher return rates than other forms of transit, about 70% of 2019 levels. The system introduced mobile ticket scanning on February 1, eliminating the need to issue transfer tickets and offering better insight into riders' travel patterns.



Service Notes

High winds temporary suspended service at the Rockaway and Bay Ridge landings in January and March. A snowstorm in February caused all ferry and shuttle service to have a delayed start and to operate on a weekend schedule. On April 5, the S. Williamsburg and DUMBO ferry landings closed for construction to replace both landings.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops made within the quarter that depart no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes past their scheduled times. This report includes delays due to events outside of the control of NYC Ferry, such as vessel traffic, river closures/obstructions, extreme weather conditions, and other U.S. Coast Guard restrictions. When tracking devices are offline, the stops are excluded from the calculation. ²Number of NYCF-branded vessels available for use. 3The LES route was reconfigured in May 2020, with the existing landings moved to other routes. 4A severe snow storm on Feb 1 canceled all service, and Feb 2 operated on a weekend schedule.
