




RIDERSHIP BY LANDING

With many people still working from home, NYC Ferry Q2 ridership continued to hold at about 65% of 2019 levels. The DUMBO and South Williamsburg landings closed on April 5 for planned landing replacement & upgrades to improve operations and ADA access. DUMBO re-opened on June 19, relocated to the historic Fulton Ferry pier.

In April, an NYC Ferry vessel was briefly pinned-in at 34th St due to strong currents and was dislodged by another NYCF vessel. In May, passengers were offloaded at Pier 6 after a South Brooklyn route vessel made contact with a construction barge. The summer schedule started on May 22.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops made within the quarter that depart no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes past their scheduled times. This report includes delays due to events outside of the control of NYC Ferry, such as vessel traffic, river closures/obstructions, extreme weather conditions, and other U.S. Coast Guard restrictions. When tracking devices are offline, the stops are excluded from the calculation. ²Number of NYCF-branded vessels available for use. ³The LES route was reconfigured in May 2020, with the existing landings moved to other routes.
