



The Rockaway Rocket pilot launched on 7/23/2022. On 9/12/2022, NYCF's fare policy changed, raising the base fare to \$4, introducing a ten-ticket pack, eliminating bike fees, and offering a \$1.35 ticket to seniors, people with disabilities, and participants in the Fair Fares NYC program.

The Greenpoint landing remained closed in Q3. The fall schedule went into effect on 9/12/2022. On 8/3-8/4, the SG route was suspended and instead NYCF operated for free between BMB Slip 5 and St. George to supplement the Staten Island Ferry. From 9/13-9/20, UNGA-related river closures impacted AS and ER

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of trips that departed no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes past their scheduled times at each landing. This report does not include delays due to events outside of the control of NYC Ferry, such as vessel traffic, river closures/obstructions, extreme weather conditions, and other U.S. Coast Guard restrictions. When tracking devices are offline, the stops are excluded from the calculation. ²Number of NYCF-branded vessels available for use.
